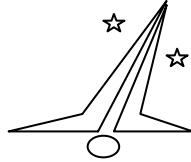

We are looking for a generous person willing to do a load of Washing for the gym once a week. If this sounds like a way you can support the club please give Sarah a call 349 3108.

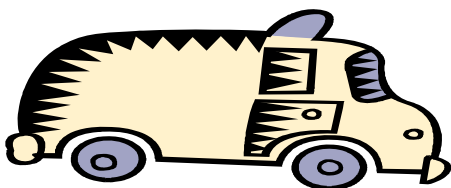


CHANGE OF ADDRESS
